The Board of Directors of the Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 5, Weld County, Colorado, held a meeting via Zoom video conference on Wednesday, November 29, 2023 at 2:00 P.M.

Ms. Randazo stated that proper publication was made to allow the Board to conduct a public hearing on the District's 2024 budget. Ms. Kaminski opened the public hearing on the District's proposed 2024 budget. There being no public comment on the District's budget, the public hearing was closed.

Thereupon, Director Gerk moved to adopt the following Resolution:

## RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION SUMMARIZING REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES, ADOPTING A BUDGET, SETTING FORTH MILL LEVIES, AND APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH HEREIN FOR THE CONESTOGA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 5, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING ON THE FIRST DAY OF JANUARY 2024, AND ENDING ON THE LAST DAY OF DECEMBER 2024,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 5 has authorized its consultants to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget has been submitted to the Board of Directors of the District for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published on November 15, 2023, in The Greeley Tribune, a newspaper having general circulation within the boundaries of the District, pursuant to statute, said proposed budget was available for inspection by the public at a designated public office, a public hearing was held on November 29, 2023, and interested electors were given the opportunity to file or register any objections to said proposed budget; and

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CONESTOGA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 5 OF WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. 2024 Budget Revenues. That the estimated revenues for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 2. 2024 Budget Expenditures. That the estimated expenditures for each fund as more specifically set out in the budget attached hereto are accepted and approved.

Section 3. Adoption of Budget for 2024. That the budget as submitted and attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and if amended, then as amended, is hereby approved and adopted as the budget of the Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 5 for calendar year 2024.

Section 4. 2024 Levy of Property Taxes. That the foregoing budget indicated that the amount of money necessary to balance the budget from property taxes for the 2024 Budget

year is \$6,462. That the 2023 valuation for assessment, as certified by the Weld County Assessor, is \$113,030.

A. Levy for General Operating Fund. That for the purposes of meeting all general operating expense of the District during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 0.000 mills upon each dollar of the 2023 total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District.

B. Levy for General Obligation Bonds and Interest. That for the purposes of meeting all general obligation bonds and interest approved at elections of the District during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 46.774 mills upon each dollar of the 2023 total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District.

C. Levy for Contractual Obligations. That for the purposes of meeting all contractual obligations expense of the District during the 2024 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 10.394 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation of assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2023.

Section 5. Property Tax and Fiscal Year Spending Limits. That, being fully informed, the Board finds that the foregoing budget and mill levies do not result in a violation of any applicable property tax or fiscal year spending limitation.

Section 6. Certification to County Commissioners. The District's manager is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Weld County, Colorado, the 57.168 mill levy for the District hereinabove determined and set. That said certification shall be in substantially the following form:

## **CONESTOGA METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NO. 5**

### **2024 BUDGET MESSAGE**

The Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 5 (the District) is a quasi-municipal political subdivision of the State of Colorado. It was organized to provide for the acquisition, construction and completion of certain infrastructure improvements within the boundaries of the District. The District is governed by a five-member Board.

#### **Basis of Accounting**

The District prepares its budget on the modified accrual basis of accounting and uses funds to budget and report on its financial position.

#### **Revenues**

##### ***Taxes***

The District imposes a mill levy of 57.168 mills. Of the 57.168 mills, 46.774 mills are pledged to District No. 2's bonds. The remaining 10.394 mills will be used for administrative and operation costs through a transfer to District No. 1.

Specific ownership taxes are set by the State and collected by the County Clerk, primarily on vehicle licensing within the County as a whole. The specific ownership taxes are allocated by the County Treasurer to all taxing entities within the County, including the District.

#### **Funds**

##### ***General Fund***

The General Fund transfers its net operations revenue to the Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 1 which accounts for the administrative and operations costs of the Districts and its net debt-related revenue to the Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 2 for the payment of annual debt service on the District's Series 2021 Bonds. The District has no employees and contracts with consultants to provide monthly services required to operate the District. The District has no operating or capital lease agreements.

#### **Emergency Reserve**

The District reserves the portion of the fund balance necessary to comply with the TABOR Amendment in the Conestoga Metropolitan District No. 1.


